Size US3 needles

Tapestry needle

Sport weight baby yarn - one solid and one multicolor.

(I used Bernat Baby Coordinates for the solid color "cake" area, because of the crinkly texture, shine, and lovely colors. And TLC Baby for the multicolored "frosting")

C/o 8 st

Rnd 1: with cake color pass alternate st on 2 circs (4 st on ea circ) and k around.

Rnd 2: Inc ev st (16 st)

Rnd 3: k around

Rnd 4: Inc ev st (32 st)

Rnd 5: k around

Rnd 6: purl

Rnd 7- 12: k around (k more rounds for a taller one)

Rnd 13: purl

Begin stuffing

Rnd 14: attach frosting color. K around

Rnd 15: k2tog. k4. k2tog, around

Rnd 16: k arnd

Rnd 17: k2tog. k2. k2tog, around

Rnd 18: k arnd

Finish stuffing

Rnd 19: k2tog arnd

Break yarn and weave end thru remaining st 2x.

Weave in ends



"Berry" for top

C/o 3

Row 1: k1, p1, k1

Row 2: kfb, k1, kfb (5 st)

Row 4-8: (k1, p1) across

Row 9: k2tog, p1, k2tog

Row 10: k1, p1, k1

Row 11: k3tog

Break yarn leaving a long tail and pull through last st.

Using tapestry needle, weave tail around all outside edges and pull tight to gather into a little ball. Using yarn tails, sew to top of cake.
